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MURAZAR COLLEGE PROFILE

Murazar College was established in the year 1989 with a grand mission to disseminate knowledge of higher education to the students of religious and linguistic minority and rural area of greater Murazar region under the District of Nagaon of Assam.

During 1980's some concerned citizens mooted the idea of setting up of a senior college for creating facilities for college level education at Murazar. With this aim, a public meeting was convened by Late Alhaj Forman Ali, Ex.-MLA, Late Adv, Abdul Choudhury and Amiruddin Ahmed. The meeting was held on 8th August 1989 in the premises of Murazar H.S. School under the chairmanship of the Ex-MLA. This public meeting formed an executive committee and authorized it to start the spadework for establishing a college at Murazar. The renowned educationist late- Abdus Salam was the former and founder principal of Murazar College. It is noted that Murazar College is the only higher education institute facilitating the students to get degree education who are socially and economically week.

The college is situated at Murazar which is well connected by all seasons of PWD road. The College can be approached from Nilbagan to Howraghat road which is connected to the four line express highway. It is located at a distance of 55 km from Nagaon town and 16 km away from Hojai town. The college since its establishment has been consistently maintaining high academic standard and good institutional responsibilities. The college is a single stream Arts college and the medium of instruction is English and Assamese. It is permanently affiliated to the Gauhati University and to be affiliated under Rabindranath Tagore University, Hojai (Assam). The College has already been recognised under section 2 (f) of the UGC Act, 1956.

In the initial stage the financial burden of the teaching and non teaching staff and all other borne by the College GB and only source of income was student's fees. In the inaugurate year, there were 17 students only however, at present we have 958 students studying in the college. From the humble beginning the college has attained this structure because of hard and dedicated endeavour of the faculties, the College GB, students and local public. The college is now running in its own land and building.



PERMISSION, AFFILIATION AND RECOGNITION:

The college got permission from Gauhati University in 1993. It has also been affiliated of this University. It has got concurrence from the Govt. of Assam. The college is in its 32 years of service towards imparting quality education. The college has been notified as examination centre for all university examinations (undergraduate). It has been provincialised on w.e.f. 1st January-2021. The college has been to be affiliated under Rabindranath Tagore University, Hojai. The college has already been recognised under section 2 (f) of the UGC Act, 1956.

LOCATION:

The college is situated at Murazar which is well connected by all seasons PWD roads. The college can be approached from Nilbagan by Nilbagan-Howraghat road which is connected to four line express highway. It is located at a distance of 55 km from Nagaon town and 16 km. from Hojai town. It is 9 km. from Howraghat town. The college is well connected from all direction by all weather PWD roads.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

In normal sense, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell works to make plans, guides and monitors the quality Assurance and Quality Enhancement activities in any Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). The IQAC shall not be called as record keeping cell only but it shall channelize the efforts to pull up an Institutions in the path of Academic Excellence.

As per the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) guidelines every preaccredited and post-accredited higher education institutions must have its own Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). This is very much essential to maintain the Pre & post-accreditation quality of any HEIs. Being the Quality Enhancement is a continuous process hence; the IQAC becomes an essential part for each and every HEIs system and works towards the realization of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance.

The pre accredited IQAC Committee of Murazar College is constructed on 24-06-2022; vide GB Res. No.05 as per the latest guidelines of NAAC. The Committee is consisted of 17 Office bearers under the Chairmanship of Dr. Sayed Ahammed Ali, Principal, Murazar College. Mr. Nozmul Hoque, Assistant Professor Department of Education is nominated as the 1st IQAC Coordinator of this committee. The IQAC committee is formed with Principal, IQAC Coordinator, Assistant IQAC Coordinator, other Teacher's representatives, Distinguished Educationist, local managements, student's representative and a few stakeholders as a member.

The IQAC of Murazar College is taking up several quality assurances steps through curricular and co curricular activities and also trying to create a good environment to maintain files and documents and also developing the institutional database for the entire college.

Murazar College has been provincialised in the Year 2021 and the 1st Cycle of NAAC accreditation is going on. The IQAC team of Murazar College is trying the best to bring up a better result for our College.

The Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) based on NEP-2020; 1st semester admission will be held under Rabindranath Tagore University, Hojai and admission into FYUGP 3rd semester & B.A. (CBCS) 5th Semester admission will be held under Gauhati University. The course structure of FYUGP is built on the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS). Though, the FYUGP is basically a CBCS, it is radically different from the courses running under CBCS. Namely, it does not differentiate between so-called Honours and Pass courses existing under CBCS. Basically, the FYUGP is based on the system of education under Liberal Arts.



SALIENT FEATURES: Structure-wise, the present Bachelor's Degree programme under the CBCS is a 3-year degree programme at the end of which, a student will be awarded a Bachelor's Degree in Arts, Science, or Commerce. One can also have a Bachelor's of Vocation degree, being run in some colleges, which in short form known as the BVoc degree. The two systems – Bachelor's Course under CBCS and Bachelor's Course under the FYUGP of NEP are different in the following ways.


DURATION: While under CBCS, one has a 3-year degree programme, under the NEP's FYUGP, it is a 4-year degree programme.

EXITS & ENTRIES: Under CBCS, one needs to complete the full 3-year programme in order to get a degree. There is no provision for dropping out of the programme in the middle. While in the FYUGP, one has choice to exit from the programme thrice – after one year, after two years, and after three years. If one exits the programme after one year, one gets a certificate. If one exits after two years, one gets a diploma. If one exits after three years, one gets a Bachelor's Degree. And finally if a student completes the whole 4-year, one gets a Bachelor's Degree (Honours).

Rabindranath Tagore University: Four Year Under Graduate Programme

(Based on UGC Curriculum and Credit Framework)

The Rabindranath Tagore University has adopted under graduate Course curriculum Framework (UGCF) under New Education Policy, 2020 to be implemented from August, 2023. It is a structure for four-year under Graduate programmes in different disciplines with multiple exit options.

Important Points:

- Student opts to exit after completion of 1st year securing 40 credits s/he may be awarded a UG Certificate,
 if s/he completed one vocational course of 4 credits during summer vacation of first year.
- 2. Student opts to exit after completion of 2nd year securing 80 credits s/he may be awarded a UG Diploma,if s/he completed one vocational course of 4 credits during summer vacation of second year.
- 3. Student opts to exit after completion of either 1st year or completion of 2nd year may be allowed to re-enter within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.
- 4. Student opts to exit after completion of third year securing 120 credits will be eligible for UG degree with Major discipline without Honours.
- 5. For 4-year Honours degree the major subject/discipline requires 80 credits and the minor subject/discipline requires 32 credits. The student who exits after completion of 6th Semester/3rd Year, s/he requires 60 credits in the major subject/discipline and 24 credits in the minor subject/discipline.
- 6. Students who intend to complete four year degree programme will have two options in 7th and 8th semester as:
 - i) Students who choose Research in 4th year are to study DSC-16, DSC-17, and DSC-18 of 4 credits eachand to complete a dissertation/project of 4 credits mandatorily in 7th semester.
 - Accordingly, in 8th semester these students will study DSC-19, DSC-20 of 4 credits each and to complete a dissertation/project of 8 credits.
 - ii) Students who don't choose Research will study DSC-21*, DSC-22*, DSC-23* mandatorily in lieu of dissertation/project in 7thand8thsemester in addition to (DSC-16 to DSC-20) leading to Honours without Research.
- 7. Students who completed four year degree programme with dissertation/project will be awarded Bachelor Degree of Honours with Research. And students who completed four year degree without dissertation/project will be awarded Bachelor Degree of Honours.

ELIGIBILITY OF ADMISSION

Admission to FYUGP B.A 1st Semester class is opened for those who have passed H.S. (10+2) Standard Examination conducted by AHSEC, CBSE or any other equivalent exam.

PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION

Admission to all programs is governed by the College Admission Rules which strictly maintains the order of merit of the students. All decisions of the Admission Committee for 2024-25 Session, regarding admission to different disciplines will be final and binding.

- A. Applicants seeking admission into Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) offered by the college should go through the web portal https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in & www.murazarcollege.org. Thereby the applicants are also directed to download the prospectus and read it thoroughly before filling the online application.
- B. Minimum qualifying marks for opting for a major by a student of his / her choice is 55% in the concerned subject and overall 50% marks in his / her last qualifying examination.
- C. Admission to the college shall be based strictly on MERIT.
- D. A student desiring admission must submit his / her duly filled in admission form within the stipulated date, as fixed by the College authority. Incomplete and delayed submission of application forms will be summarily rejected without intimation to the candidate. Merit List & Date of Admission will be notified soon on the college website after the completion of verification process.
- E. The applicants shall have to upload Marksheet, Caste Certificate, Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended, Admit Card, Income Certificate (for free admission) from concerned circle officer and other relevant documents along with the application.
- F. At the time of admission, the candidate shall have to produce the following original documents before the Admission Committee.
 - i) Original marksheet of the last qualifying examination.
 - ii) Original certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
 - iii) Admit Card of the last qualifying examination
 - iv) Caste Certificate.
 - v) Income Certificate (for free admission) from concerned circle officer.



RESERVATION OF SEATS:

Seat for SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/PwD candidates are reserved as per government rules (GoI). Students seeking admission in such category will have to produce caste certificate from appropriate authority at the time of interview and admission.

ATTENDENCE:

Attendence is compulsory in all classes. Students shall be required to attend at least 75% of lectures for theoritical as well as practical classes seperately to become eligible to sit in the final examination, if not, otherwise disqualified for the same.

CANCELLATION OF SEAT:

A student failing to attend classes for thirty (30) days at a stretch without any reason shall forfeit his/her seat.

STUDENT UNIFORM:

Boys: Black pant and White full sleeve shirt.

Girls: White selowar and Kameez with sky blue scarf/dupatta.

Note: Wearing of college uniform is compulsory during college hours, college week, Seminar, Examination and any other activities related to college.

IDENTITY CARDS:

An Identity card issued to every students should be possessed by them during college hours and students without uniform and Identity Card will not be allowed to enter into the College premises.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- i) A student will be subjected to disciplinary action if he/she is found to be disobidient or indecent in his/her behaviour with the teaching and non-teaching staff and students as well.
- ii) A student who is found to have violated college rules shall be liable to expulsion.
- iii) Admission fee and all other fees are to be paid at a time for the whole year on the day of admission. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- iv) Each academic session will run as per academic calender embodies in the prospectus.
- v) Students entering the college compound with arms is illegal and subjected to disciplinary action.
- vi) Ragging is strictly prohibited. If a student is found guilty he/she will be liable to punishment.
- vii) Smoking, Tabacco sewing, use Wine, Spitting & Writing on walls, doors, windows, benches and Laboratory etc. in and around the college compound is strictly prohibited. Any student detected doing so will be liable to punishment.
- viii) Mobile phones arc strictly forbidden during class and examination hours. Any violation is subjected to severe disciplinary action.
- ix) The decicion of the Principal on all matters relating to students shall be final and binding.
- x) All students should read the notice in the notice board and visit the college website regularly.

ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

An orientation programme will he held on first day of new session 2024-25 for the admitted students into FYUGP courses. It is mandatory for all students to attend the orientation programme.

EXAMINATION

Attendance in sessional examination and departmental examination conducted in the college is compulsory. Students failing to pass the Sessional Examination will not be allowed to sit in the final examination.
